

# ELDORADO TRAIL

Terminus

This historical trail that dates back to the gold rush is a well used trail that leads the user up into the alpine of the Eldorado valley, it originated as an access trail to a dam built for mining over 120 years ago.

The trail winds through a mixed spruce and subalpine fir forest and terminates in the Sentinel bowl above treeline. The route to the summit of Mt. Sentinel (1923 m.) is unmarked.

**Keep an eye out for trail markers to help you on your way.**
