Trailhead

The Warmsprings Trail follows an historic wood road. The Warmsprings/Warm Bay Recreation Site is a micro-ecology featuring a variety of endemic plant and animal species. The trail terminates on a ridge with a view to Atlin Provincial Park, including Mt. McCallum and Paradise Peak.

This is a single track trail, please do not use four-wheel vehicles (ATVs, side-by-sides, etc.) Thank you!

Keep an eye out for trail markers to help you on your way.
